Dear Camper,

Thank you for your Camp Registration; we are pleased you have decided to be part of the VILLANOVA FIELD HOCKEY CAMP. Below, we have outlined some important information that you may find helpful concerning this summer's camp.

CHECK-IN / CHECK-OUT:

1. All campers will **CHECK-IN anytime between 10:00am and 12:00pm on Wednesday, June 20, 2018 at GOOD COUNSEL HALL**. Good Counsel Hall is located on our South Campus on Ithan Avenue. You will turn off of Lancaster Avenue onto Ithan Avenue. Go under the train tracks and then take a left into our South Campus. The dorm will be on your right. Parking is to the right and left. Please refer to the posted signs to guide your way. We will begin our First Session promptly at 1:00 p.m.
2. **CHECK-OUT will be immediately following the final training/games on the closing day of camp Friday, June 22, 2018 at 3:00pm**. You will park in our new Parking Garage (see I-1 on map) and all campers will be dismissed from Villanova Stadium. All the campers belongings will already be out of the dorm and stored in the Stadium.

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING TO CHECK-IN * IMPORTANT!!:

1. Balance Due if you have not paid in full.
2. Amount of money for establishing a Camp Bank Account, Cash or Checks will be accepted. (We recommend \$50.00) Any money left in your account will be returned to the camper. We provide this service for safety so the girls don't need to carry money or leave money in the dorm room.

***VERY IMPORTANT! No camper will be allowed to participate in activities until this information is obtained.

ACCOMMODATIONS AND FACILITIES:

1. DORM: The OVERNIGHT CAMPERS will use the following dorms this summer – **GOOD COUNSEL HALL** – located on South Campus. These dorms are **AIR CONDITIONED!**
2. COMMUTER CAMPERS will have access to a lounge for their use during the camp free time.
3. DINING HALL: The camp dining facility is located on Main Campus DOUGHERTY HALL
4. TURF FIELDS: All training sessions will be held at our **NEW Villanova Field Hockey Field located** in nearby Conshohocken and the turf fields at Villanova University. We will be transporting the campers to our new facility by charter bus.

COMMUTER CAMPERS:

PLEASE NOTE: If you are a COMMUTER CAMPER – drop off your child each morning at her assigned field. If she is going to our Villanova Field in Conshohocken please drop her off at the Parking Garage for the Charter Bus pick up. Please check the schedule to see each day where she will be for her first session. Wednesday and Thursday nights you can pick up your child at 8:00pm in front of the dorm.

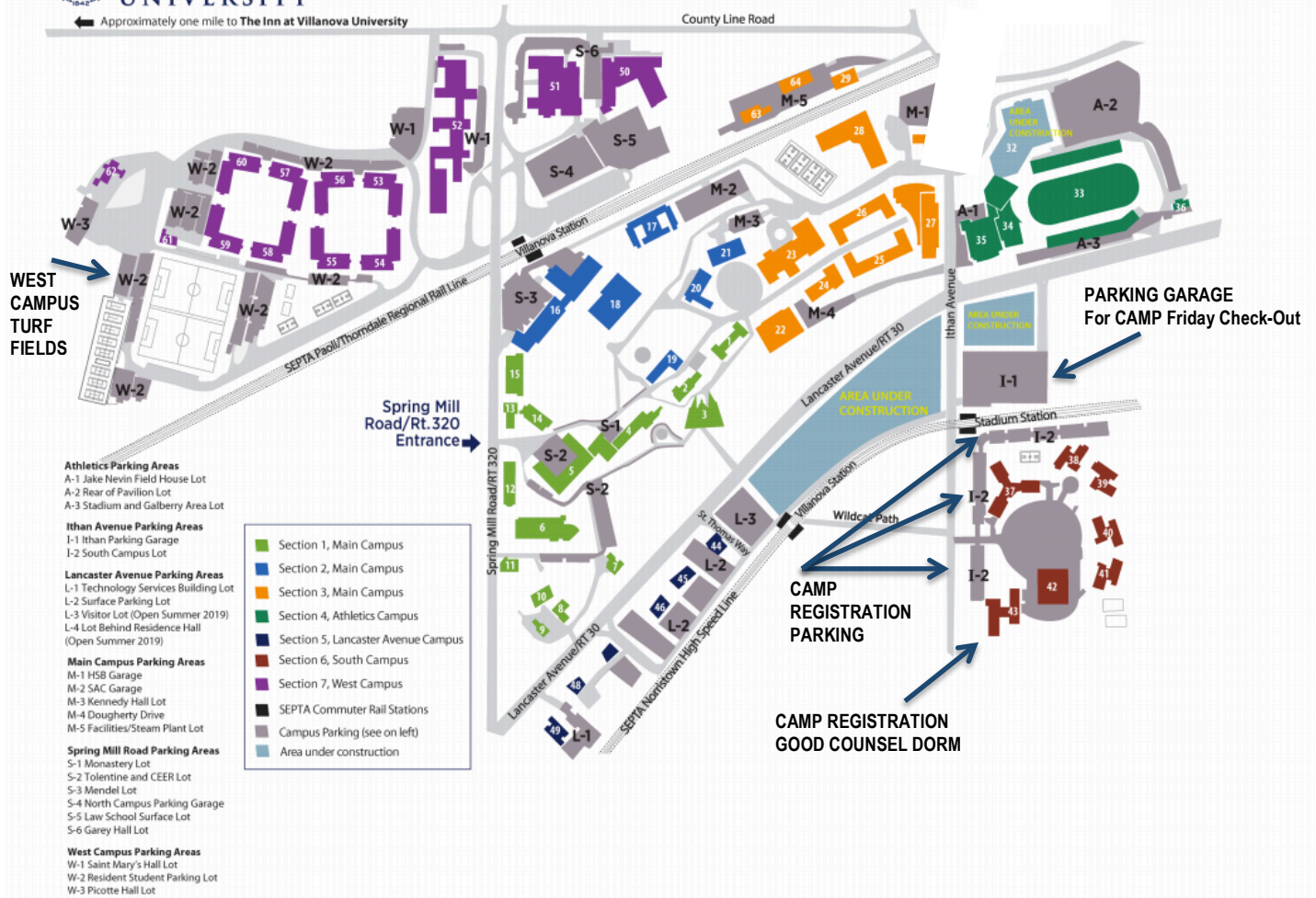

Directions

BY CAR:

For GPS systems, our address is: 800 E. Lancaster Avenue, Villanova, PA 19085 (Lancaster and Ithan Avenues)

From New York and New England: Take the New Jersey Turnpike (I-95) to Exit 6 (Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-276)). Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-276) Westbound to Exit 20 (Mid-County Interchange I-476 South/Chester). Follow I-476 South to Exit 13 (Villanova/St. Davids). At the bottom of ramp turn right and proceed east on Lancaster Avenue (US-30) for just over a mile to Ithan Avenue and turn right. Proceed half a block south on Ithan Avenue and the Ithan Avenue Parking Garage will be on your left.

From the West: Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-76) to Exit 326 (Valley Forge). Take I-76 (Schuylkill Expressway) to Exit 331A (I-476 South/Chester). Follow I-476 South to Exit 13 (Villanova/St. Davids). At the bottom of ramp turn right and proceed east on Lancaster Avenue (US-30) for just over a mile to Ithan Avenue and turn right. Proceed half a block south on Ithan Avenue and the Ithan Avenue Parking Garage will be on your left.

From the South: Take I-95 North to Exit 7 (I-476 North Plymouth Meeting). Take I-476 North to Exit 13 (Villanova/St. Davids). At the bottom of ramp turn right and proceed east on Lancaster Avenue (US-30) for just over a mile to Ithan Avenue and turn right. Proceed half a block south on Ithan Avenue and the Ithan Avenue Parking Garage will be on your left.

BY TRAIN:

Take AMTRAK or New Jersey Transit (via SEPTA) to the 30th Street Station in Philadelphia. Ask the attendant to direct you to the Regional Rail Trains (SEPTA). Take the Paoli/Thorndale Local train to the Villanova Station, located on our campus. Wheelchair access: All Airport and Center City stations are wheelchair accessible, however, Villanova Station is not. Continue on the train past Villanova to the wheelchair accessible Wayne Station and from there take a taxi (prearranged) to the Villanova campus.
